1. Introduction

(a) About ICAI

The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) is a statutory body established by the Chartered Accountants Act, 1949 (Act No.XXXVIII of 1949), an Act of Parliament. This body is entrusted with the regulation and development of the Chartered Accountancy profession in the country. Under the administrative control of the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India, the ICAI stands as the largest professional body of Chartered Accountants globally, maintaining a steadfast commitment to serving the Indian economy in the public interest.

The governance of ICAI is overseen by a Council, operating in accordance with the Chartered Accountants Act, 1949, and the Chartered Accountants Regulations, 1988. Comprising 40 members, 32 are elected by Chartered Accountants, while the remaining 8 are nominated by the Central Government, representing entities such as the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, Securities and Exchange Board of India, Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Ministry of Finance, and other stakeholders.

Over time, ICAI has earned recognition as the largest accounting body, not only within the country but also globally, for upholding the highest standards in technical and ethical areas. It has consistently maintained rigorous examination and education standards since its inception in 1949, leading to substantial growth in terms of members and student base.

(b) About Sustainability Reporting Standards Board (SRSB)

The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) has a strong tradition of service to the country towards sustainable as well as economic development. ICAI strives to bring sustainability reporting and thinking within mainstream business practices, both in the public and private sectors. ICAI through SRSB is taking proactive steps to not only identify and develop opportunities for Chartered Accountants in Sustainability Reporting but also to enhance knowledge, upskill and train members by conducting workshops, seminars, and certificate course, publish technical literature on various important topics within the sustainability domain. Further, in its endeavor to promote sustainability reporting ecosystem in the country which would lead to a greener low-carbon economy, the Institute is working on two crucial aspects. Firstly, to promote compliance with existing accounting and sustainability-related disclosure requirements. Secondly, to strengthen the assurance framework to build a solid bridge between sustainability-related risks and corporate financial reporting.

(c) Action Plan of SRSB, ICAI Standard Setting & Implementation

- Identify priority areas and formulate/issue Sustainability Reporting Standards and Sustainability Assurance/Assessment Engagement Standards.
- Formulate and issue Social Impact Assessment Standards, Technical Guides, Implementation Guides, and related educational material.

- Develop/enhance sustainability reporting platforms, analytical tools, and compliance techniques.
- Issue interpretations, guidance notes, technical guides, and education material for implementation.
- Develop audit guidance and resources for Integrated Reporting.
- Benchmark global best practices in sustainability reporting and assurance.



Communication & Collaboration

- Engage Government, regulators, industry associations, and international bodies to promote adoption of standards.
- Address industry-specific implementation issues and collaborate with national/international organizations.
- Identify and create opportunities for CAs in sustainability reporting and assurance.
- Promote adoption of Sustainability Reporting Standards by Local Bodies and Panchayats.
- Contribute to international bodies and think tanks on standard development.
- Conduct research and publish on Green Finance, Green/Carbon Credits, and facilitate inter-regulatory collaboration.
- Organize awareness and training programs on Social Stock Exchange (SSE) registration/listing; train CAs as business advisors for SSEs.

Knowledge Sharing & Capacity Building

- Conduct workshops, webinars, seminars, courses, quizzes, sustainability drives, and Train-the-Trainer programs in India and abroad.
- Organize talk shows, expert discussions, and knowledge-sharing sessions on sustainability developments.

Recognition

- Institute and organize Sustainability Reporting Awards to recognize outstanding sustainable and inclusive business performance.

Internal Measures

- Recommend and implement ICAI-wide awareness initiatives, celebration of environment / sustainability days, sustainable practices, ESG integration, and carbon-neutral projects.

Knowledge Repository

- Maintain and enrich the SRSB knowledge repository with case studies, best practices, expert insights, green finance/carbon credit research, social impact assessment resources, and SSE guidance.

- To champion best practices in BRSR and inspire others to adopt robust sustainability reporting frameworks.





This updated edition provides an in-depth understanding of sustainability concepts, frameworks, and reporting mechanisms, making it an essential resource for Chartered Accountants, accounting professionals, and students.



5. ICAI Carbon Emission Calculator

- On 1st July 2025, SRSB launched the ICAI Carbon Emission Calculator — a free, dynamic and user-friendly digital tool.
- It enables organizations and individuals to measure, manage, and disclose their carbon footprint in line with BRSR Core and GHG Protocol requirements.
- This tool helps companies bring quantitative environmental data into their reporting frameworks, supporting climate-related financial disclosures and integrated reporting.

Through the Carbon Calculator, ICAI–SRSB is equipping Indian companies to measure and manage their carbon footprint with the same discipline as financial performance — driving the shift from balance sheets to sustainability sheets.

6. Launch of ICAI SRSB Website

During the year, the Sustainability Reporting Standards Board (SRSB) of ICAI launched a dedicated sustainability portal, <https://sustainability.icai.org>, as a centralized digital platform to support sustainability reporting, assurance, and capacity-building initiatives.

7. Capacity building initiatives for Members during the year 2025-26

7.1 Programme on “Biodiversity & Business in Harmony: Role and Opportunities for Chartered Accountants”. As an initiative to promote awareness and action on biodiversity conservation, Sustainability Reporting Standards Board, ICAI, in collaboration with the United Nations Global Compact (UNGC), organized a special event on 24th May 2025 in Delhi on International Biodiversity Day 2025.



7.2 ICAI-Hosted Consultation Workshop on Workforce Nutrition Reporting

Sustainability Reporting Standards Board supported and hosted the Consultation Workshop on Introducing Nutrition into ESG Reporting – Workforce Nutrition Reporting on 3rd June 2025 at ICAI, BKC, Mumbai, in collaboration with the Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (IICA), Global Alliance for Improved Nutrition (GAIN) and the Access to Nutrition Initiative (ATNi). The workshop focused on sensitising corporates and professionals to the importance of integrating workforce nutrition into ESG reporting frameworks and assessing industry readiness for such disclosures.

7.3 ICAI Sustainability Month celebration

ICAI Sustainability Month–June 2025 was organised by the Sustainability Reporting Standards Board (SRSB) as a nationwide awareness and action campaign from 1st to 30th June 2025, reaffirming ICAI’s commitment to environmental stewardship and community engagement. With active participation from all five Regional Councils and 183 Branches, the initiative witnessed collective efforts across the country. Anchored around the **5Ps** of Sustainability—**Planet, People, Prosperity, Peace** and **Partnership**—and aligned with the Government of India’s **LIFE (Lifestyle for Environment)** mission and



the UN Sustainable Development Goals, the month-long programme featured diverse activities such as **tree plantation drives, walkathons, yoga sessions, sustainability awareness surveys and Sustainability Reel Competition.**

Throughout Sustainability Month, SRSB reinforced the roles of both individuals and institutions in advancing sustainable development and highlighted the accounting profession’s role as a catalyst for a greener, more responsible future.

7.4 World Environment Day, 5th June 2025: On 05th June 2025, the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI), through its Sustainability Reporting Standards Board (SRSB), organised a programme on **“Demystifying Sustainability, SSE, Social Audits & Opportunities for CAs”** hosted by SIRC of ICAI at Chennai. The event was inaugurated by CA. Priti Savla, Chairperson, SRSB, along with CA. Lakshmi Narayanan S and CA. Marie Banu, providing insights on topics like Social Stock Exchange and Social Audit: Opportunities for Chartered Accountants, Carbon Markets and Schedule VII to the Companies Act 2013.



7.5 The Board conducted the conference in association with IICA under the Ministry of Corporate Affairs, Government of India. ICAI organized the 3rd Edition of the National Conference on **Responsible Business Conduct (NCRBC) 2025** on 2nd and 3rd July 2025 at Hotel Taj Palace, New Delhi.





7.6 The Vasai Branch (WIRC) of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India, in association with the Sustainability Reporting Standards Board (SRSB), organized a **“National conference on Sustainability, Digital Assurance & Valuation”** on **30th November 2025**, at the Vasai Branch Premises, Mumbai. The programme covered key topics including BRSR, Social Stock Exchange, Social Impact Assessment, Digital Assurance, Sustainability, and Valuation & Tax Jurisprudence, delivered by experienced faculty members. The conference aimed to provide practical insights into emerging sustainability and assurance practices.



7.7 The Sustainability Reporting Standards Board of ICAI organized a knowledge session titled **“Navigating the Net Zero Journey”** on **23rd December 2025** in Mumbai. The programme focused on reporting, circular economy, carbon neutrality, climate action, green bonds, and ESG tools and technology. 


